Dear Applicant for Admission as an Attorney:

The Board of Bar Examiners is pleased to inform you that you have obtained a passing score on the MBE and Essay parts of the bar examination held on July 30 and 31, 2003. On the basis of the information furnished by you in your Applicant's Statement to the Board of Bar Examiners, you are excused from the character interview at this time.

In accordance with Supreme Judicial Court Rule 3:01, subsection 4.1, the Board of Bar Examiners will give required notice by posting your name in the office of the Clerk of the Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County and the Clerks of Courts for each of the other counties. Thereafter, unless objection is made, the Board of Bar Examiners will report favorably on your petition.

A formal group admission ceremony will be held at a date, time and place to be fixed by the Court. At this time the Court also affords you an alternate admission procedure and you may elect to be sworn and enrolled without being present at the formal group ceremony. However, you must be sworn and enrolled within one year of the report to the Court (Rule 3:01, subsection 5.2).

Please read carefully the enclosed "Procedure for Admission", complete it with your election, and mail it to the Clerk, Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County, One Beacon St., 4th Floor, Boston, MA 02108, so that it will be received by the due date indicated (November 14, 2003). If you have any questions regarding your admission, your attention is directed to the web site address on the enclosed form.
